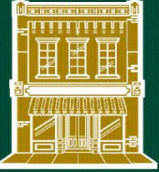

The Artist Colony of Zanesville History (COZ): The idea that “the arts would bring people of all social and economic backgrounds together and would be an excellent tool for revitalizing old and under used downtown buildings” was presented to Dana Matz and Tom Poorman in 2003 by Alan Cottrill. It began with 3 locations. Bylaws were accepted in 2005...Fast forward to 2011. We now average over 20 locations with more than 70 artists represented.
